The Arctic Hope Project, which Steven & Becky Carleton are overseeing, is ministering to the deep needs of Cape Dorset's Inuit youth. Many of the participants shared that they were suicidal before they became involved, and are now experiencing deliverance from the pain and trauma of their past, and are learning to live a life filled with purpose and hope.



The construction of the Arctic Hope Centre in Naujaat, NU (formerly Repulse Bay) is also a huge cause for rejoicing. Jeff Fransky and a team of dedicated Inuit volunteers worked tirelessly over the summer months and completed all the outside work. He will return in January to complete the inside, and we anticipate conducting a dedication and celebration service in May 2016. The Arctic Hope Centre will serve as a wonderful local church as well as the headquarters for our work in the Arctic. We are believing God to see young Inuit men and women all over the north healed and made whole, and for suicide to eradicated in the Arctic! The Light of Christ is shining bright in Canada's north!



In addition to our on going ministry "from sea to sea" and in the Canadian north, we send teams of Russian workers each year to the Russian Arctic to evangelize the lost and equip believers. Igor and his team ministered powerfully this year in several communities scattered across the Russian tundra and provided much-needed aid to the poverty-stricken families. We also support ministries in Israel as well as fellow evangelists with a heart for Canada. We are doing all we can to see the Light dispersed throughout the world.
