

We've always known that Jesus came to earth in human form to pay the price for our redemption. But we also know He set the ultimate example for us to follow. He did as His Father did, and He asks us to follow the model He set for us. 1 John 2:6 says "He who says he abides in Him ought himself also to walk just as He walked."

That seems fairly straight-forward, doesn't it? We should love as Jesus loved, forgive as He did and live a life of devotion and purity just like Him. But Jesus modeled so much more than that. He was a man of action!

Mark 5 shows us just how much Jesus loved people – enough to go way beyond his comfort zone to reach them. Verse 1 says, "They arrived at the other side of the sea in the **territory** of the Garasenes."

This was a territory that most people avoided, mainly because of Legion, a demon-possessed man who

terrorized everyone. Jesus refused to be intimidated by the destructive work the enemy was doing through this tortured man. He set out on a mission to release that poor soul from bondage and to inspire him to share the good news with others.

Through Legion's deliverance, Jesus sparked something exciting and brought a message of HOPE to those who witnessed the miracle. Legion begged to join Jesus and His disciples in their travels, but Jesus showed him a much more effective way of reaching people. He said, "Go home to your family (your territory), and tell them how much the Lord has done for you and how merciful He has been to you." So the man left and began proclaiming in the Decapolis how much Jesus had done for him. And everyone was utterly amazed." (Mark 5:18-20).

In February, Steven Carleton, along with worship leader Braden Scharfenburg and evangelist Travis Holownia, followed Jesus' example and took new TERRITORY in the Canadian Arctic. With their primary focus on the youth of Nunavut, they shared their stories of receiving freedom, forgiveness and hope in high schools in Iqaluit, Kimmirut and Cape Dorset, followed by powerful worship and the Word in a local church in each community. In each Inuit school and community, God gave the team exceptional favour, allowing them to tell a total of 140 students that their lives can be transformed and they can look to the future with HOPE as they look to the Author of HOPE and PEACE. It was thrilling to see about forty people give their lives to Christ for the first time, and many more re-commit their hearts to Him.


Kimmirut was an especially exciting community to visit, as this was **NEW TERRITORY** with no full-gospel church established. As the message in worship and the Word was shared, more than twenty lives received Jesus and experienced His supernatural love and power. One memorable miracle happened to a man who suffered from the effects of an untreated broken arm. He not only received his healing but gave his life to Jesus as well!

This exciting mission was the first of many trips that the team will undertake in Nunavut in 2018, until they have ministered in all 25 Nunavut communities that have a high school. The next tour this month will include Pangnirtung, Clyde River and Qikiqtarjuaq (formerly Broughton Island). As they did in the recent mission, they will also provide guitars to young people with an interest in worship, and Braden will hold a music seminar for them, teaching them the basics and helping them to become worshippers who can touch others through this powerful medium.


